

BCHS Dress Code

All students are expected to wear proper attire to school in order to foster an environment that promotes learning.

The CCSD/ BCHS dress code:

- Requires the wearing of shoes with soles.
- Prohibits crop tops (no skin showing between bottom of shirt/blouse and top of pants/skirts); strapless, low-cut clothing; clothing with slits or holes above the knee; or tops and outfits that provide minimum coverage.
- Prohibits spaghetti straps. All sleeveless shirts must have straps at least three inches wide and that cover the shoulder.
- Requires that all shorts, skirts and dresses be fingertip length. Shorts must be hemmed and without fraying.
- Prohibits the wearing of headgear on campus, except for designated school-approved uniforms or at authorized athletic practices or activities.
- Prohibits slogans or advertising on clothing that by their controversial or obscene nature disrupts the educational setting. Clothing with spikes or studs is also prohibited.
- Requires coats, mittens and scarves to be removed upon entering the classroom.
- Requires that all undergarment clothing be covered at all times.
- Prohibits the wearing of pajama tops and bottoms, except for school-approved activities.

****The school administration has the right to designate which types of dress or appearance disrupt or detract from the educational program and may be a potential safety hazard.**
