REQUIREMENTS

- To graduate from the Clark County School District, with a High School Diploma, students must complete their required course work.
- Students who do not complete all requirements for a diploma will not be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies.
- Students earning an adjusted diploma will be eligible to participate in graduation ceremonies.



CAPS AND GOWNS

- Caps & Gowns have been ordered through Jostens.
- Payments of \$50 must be made through the banker.
- Students will get to keep their caps & gowns following graduation.
- All fees and fines must be paid before the gowns will be issued.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed in the cafeteria prior to the GRAD walk on May 10th.



MEDALS AND CORDS

- Students in a club should see their club advisor regarding their cords: (i.e. Band, NHS, Student Council etc...)
- Students receiving an Advanced Diploma, Advanced Honors Diploma, College and Career Diploma, GPA Academic Distinction—High Honors or Honors will need to pay the banker. They will bring their receipt to the main office to receive their cord/medal/stole).
- Students who meet the criteria can purchase regalia from banker after May 1, 2024
- Prices vary from \$10-12

SENIOR CHECKOUT

The Counselors will complete the Senior Checkout Process:

- Students will be required to have met all of their academic requirements for Graduation to participate in the grad walk and graduation.
- The banker and the librarian will verify that seniors are free of all fines/missing books etc...
- Seniors will be required to turn in their school issued Chromebook.
- Once academics are verified, and there are no outstanding fines, or chromebooks, students will receive their tickets for graduation.



DIPLOMA DISTRIBUTION

- During the ceremony, students will receive a diploma cover.
- The actual diploma will be distributed immediately following the ceremony behind the stage.

Students get to keep their caps and gowns as they were paid for.

Getting Ready

What do I wear?

Appropriate Attire

Clothing: A light-colored shirt with a collar, dark slacks, socks, and dress shoes. Tie is optional. Or a dress, or nice pants and light colored shirt.

Appropriate shoes: No flip-flop sandals or athletic type shoes will be permitted. Be cautious in choosing heels - high heels may cause difficulties when navigating the steps to the stage and will become painful when standing on concrete for an hour.

Caps and gowns: Must not have anything attached to or written on the outside of either the cap or gown. Gowns need to be ironed or steamed. Be careful of temperature as they scorch easily.

The graduation cap mortar boards must remain free of any decorations.

Index Card

- You will receive your card when you arrive at the theater.
- Line up in the numerical order. Order number is on line-up card. Each number begins with an R or L.
- Graduates only in the line-up area
- Dorian will be taking photos in lobby
- Graduates should be lined up and ready no later than 7 pm..
- Staff will be in the line-up area to assist.
- This is not the same line-up as Grad Walk


