 - Mr. Steckelberg will create the MAP test sessions and assign the appropriate accommodations and tests. Please send teach.mapnwea.org login information to Mr. Steckelberg.
- November 30-December 1st**
 - English 9&10 Teachers will conduct mini-lesson on preparing students for MAP testing, facilitate a device readiness check for students, and have them take the practice test.

 - All teachers should review the [MAP Proctor Quick Start Guide](#) and also become familiar with the MAP platform to prepare themselves for common issues.
- December 1st:** Mr Steckelberg will send an email reminder to all families.
- December 2nd, 2020:** Teachers with 9 and/or 10th grade students in their advisory groups conduct remote MAP Growth assessments. You will need to run a Meet session (to help students troubleshoot) while you proctor. I recommend you make a [SLIDE](#) including the Session Name and Session Password to present on your Meet screen.
- December 9th, 2020:** Office will proctor remote makeup tests.
