2.0 Distance Learning 2020-2021

1. **Distance Education:** Although we are considered a rural school, we were unable to start the school year using the hybrid or face to face model of instruction due to the fact all three health guideline conditions to do so were not met.

- Community Health Conditions: Boulder City itself is okay as far as Covid-19 cases go, but many students and staff come from Henderson where the number of Covid-19 cases is higher.
 - Staffing: one-third of the school's staff is currently telecommuting.
2. **Canvas:** 667 Boulder City High School students have logged onto Canvas so far this school year.
 3. **Attendance:** 85% attendance rate
 4. **Projected Numbers:** BCHS was projected at 668 students for the 2020-2021 school year. Currently we have 662 students, although no show students will eventually be withdrawn. There are 147 students attending our school on Open Enrollment and eight students attending on a Zone Variance. There are also 89 students who are zoned for BCHS, but are attending school elsewhere.
 5. **Budget:** Count Day on September 11, 2020 will determine our budget amount. We will receive \$125 for each student. There will not be a need to surplus any teaching or staffing positions at BCHS.
