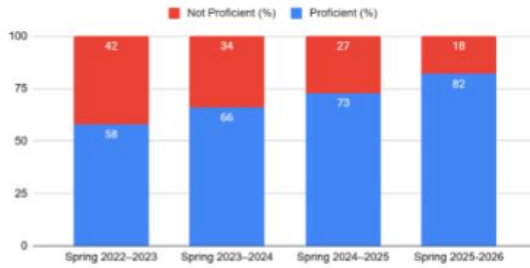

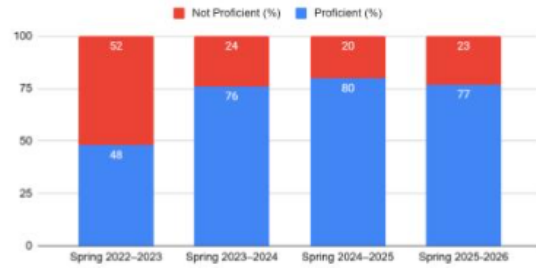

Reading MAP Overview – 41st Percentile Proficiency



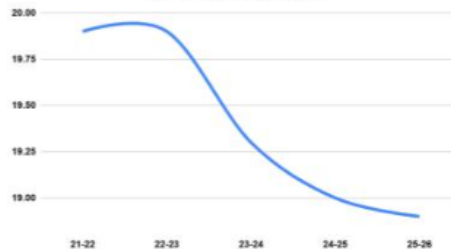

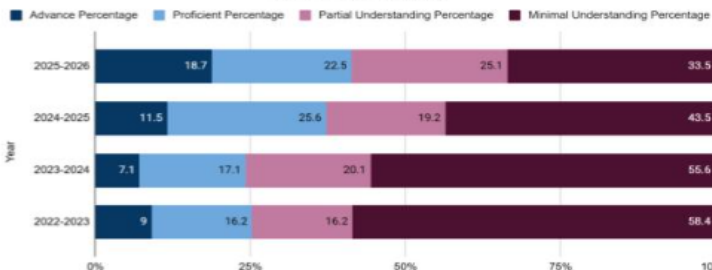

How much students feel that they are valued members of the school community.

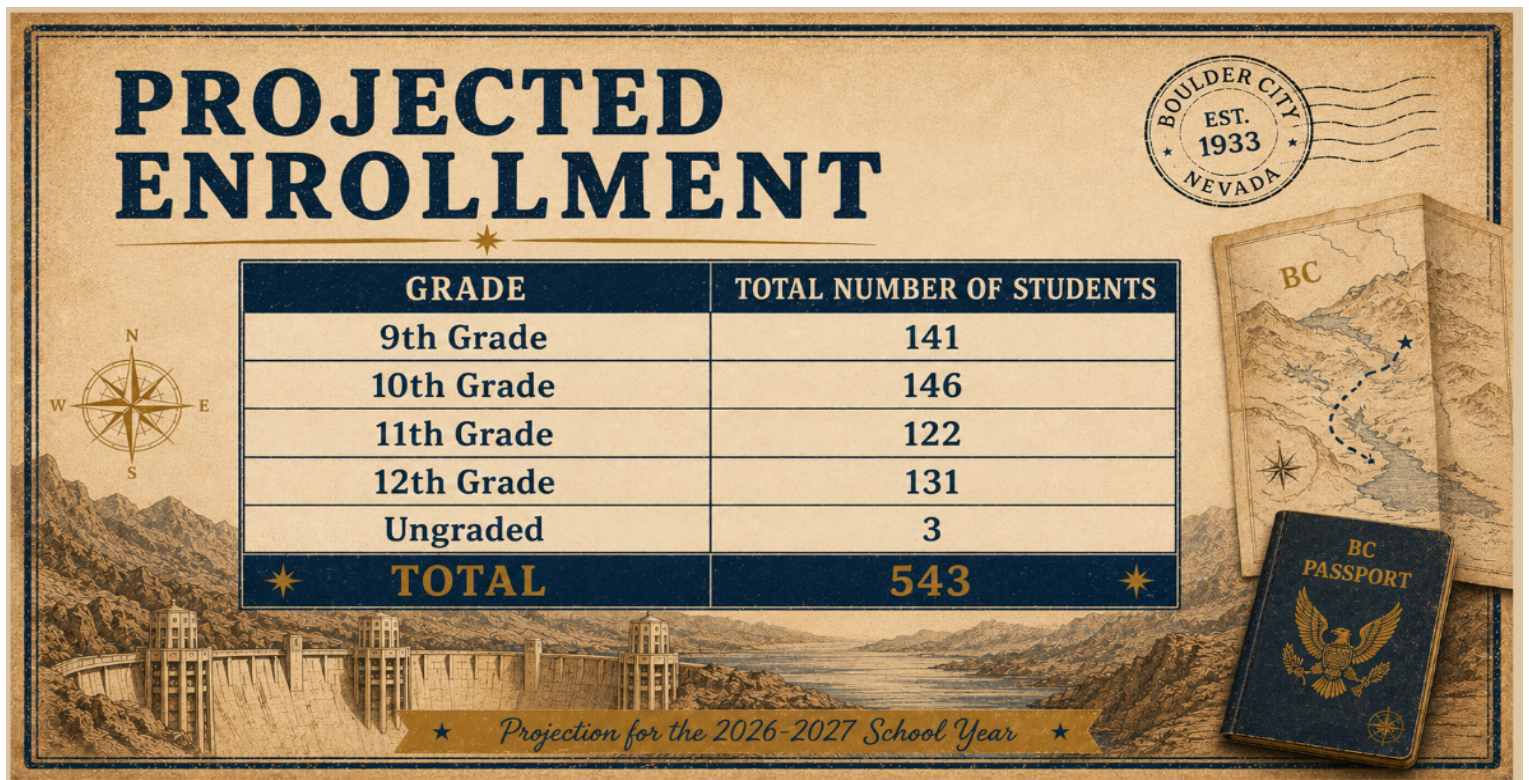
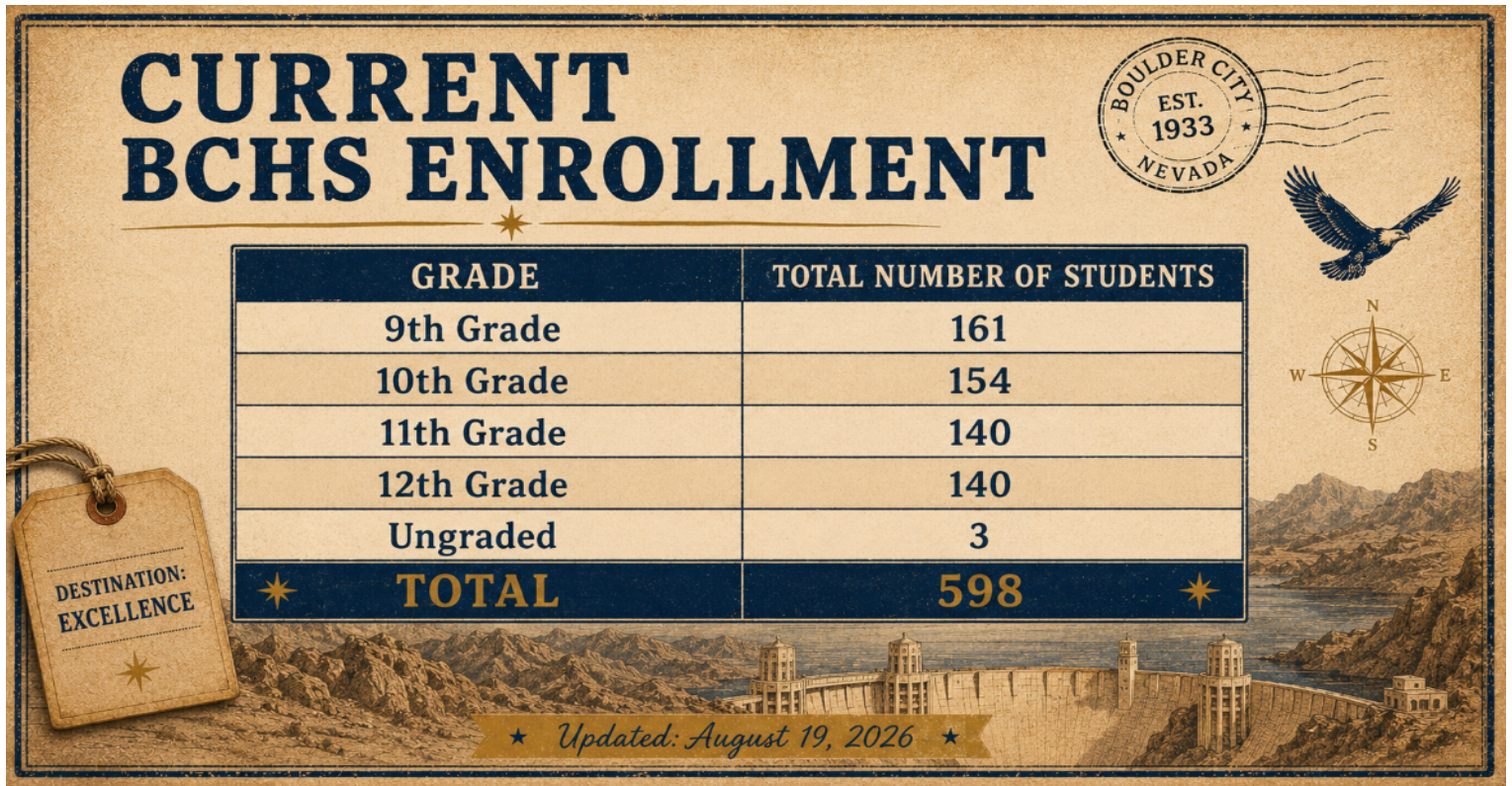
How have results changed over time?
